It's a time to remember to the past and be grateful to God for the reforms brought to the church by individuals like Martin Luther. Luther brought us a gospel message of grace through faith, not through works. This message is just as relevant today as it was 500 years ago and we, as a church are called to proclaim and live out the gospel message.

We do this as a church through the three "expressions" of the church. First, here at Center. Our local congregation is in a community. We are called to be light in the darkness. Through our service to our neighbors, events that we run throughout the year, and the outreach that we do, we are proclaiming the message of Jesus to those around us – our neighbors.

Second, the synod. Synod means walking together. And that's what we do through the synod. We walk together with other ELCA congregations in proclaiming God's love to south central PA. The synod is a valuable resource and makes sharing the Gospel message more effective in the larger area. The synod makes it possible for me to be serving at Center, works with hunger agencies to feed many in our region, and does faith formation through the Lutheran Camping Corporation, among so many other things.

Lastly, church wide. The last expression of the church is the national church. This doesn't mean that it is the most important. Rather, it serves to proclaim the gospel by working with synods and congregations on a national and international level. Through the church wide structure the church is able to support disaster relief efforts like Lutheran World Relief, continue ecumenical dialogue for understanding with our brothers and sisters in Christ in other denominations, and work with seminaries and candidacy committees as they prepare future leaders within the church.

As you can see 2017 isn't just an opportunity to look back, but it is also an opportunity to look forward and be a part of Christ's mission to the world. Let us gor forward into that challenge with faith, hope, and love.
